Our third quarter was challenging from a financial picture, with income of just over \$2,000. This is, I believe, reflective of a lack of activity on our part. However, we were placed on hold by the Indian government, along with all Not for Profit organizations in the country, pending review of our operation. I am pleased to report that we passed with flying colors and are now free to begin construction.

To this end, we are going on a fact finding trip to India from November 11 through the 25th. I will be traveling with Tracy Candelaria, wife of Criss, our Foundation Board Secretary. Our assignment is to take a step by step review and evaluation of the current progress and planned activities for the coming year and document the entire trip with pictures and narrative upon returning home. I believe it is important to mention that all trip expenses will be borne by Tracy and myself. As stated in the past, ALL donations have and will continue to flow directly to the House of Onions. Your generosity will not be misused in any way. We are all in this for the children now and into the future.

The news media in our area is extremely supportive and promise to have followup interviews and articles upon our return. Should any of you have connections to publications of value, we will be more than happy to spend time with them, either be phone, Internet or personal interviews. We have also made connections in new territories in the last quarter and have increased our donor base by 15%.

Most recently, we launched a Facebook page for the House of Onions and are getting many positive responses. Although I am still a fledgeling on the social media scene, this is apparently the wave of future mass communications. Our primary job is to do everything in our power to build a support group for the House of Onions to assure a secure future for these needy children in the worst of situations.
